Work Shop – Sewer Ordinance #139

Thursday October 8, 2015 4:30

Present: Mayor Shaha, Councilpersons Strand, Hewitt, Brockway and MacDonald.

Guests: Sharon Strand, Ruth Guthrie.

Call to order by Mayor Shaha at 4:35 P.M

Discussion on the sewer ordinance:

Mayor and council reviewed ordinance draft submitted by councilman Strand, and additional drafts and options presented by Councilman Hewitt, Councilman MacDonald and Councilwoman Brockway.

Depreciation: Concern regarding Year to date expenses and depreciation. Budgeted depreciation is 248,000.

General fund shouldn't be funding any of the costs associated with usage of the system. System needs to be dependent on users supporting all costs.

Title of an ordinance needs to be short, but cover what is in ordinance and include the effective date and repealing of Ordinance 136.

Definitions: Discussions regarding what definitions need to remain in ordinance. BOD-need to delete, as it's not in rest of ordinance. Will also delete definition of pH and Sludge as not pertinent to document. It was determined that slug should remain in.

System Maintenance: Interpretation of 104, Customer pays for tank replacement. Maintenance would be done by the city, but customer would be responsible for the cost.

Connections: All new premises shall connect when within 300ft (Remove Existing) from this paragraph).

Lateral installation cost: Discussion of whether cost of installing a new lateral should fall to the customer or be city cost.

Sewer Permit Section: building sewer drains are covered in building code, don't need in ordinance. Nothing in ordinance about following plumbing code may need to add a section to cover that.

Councilwoman Brockway made a motion to adjourn at 6:05

Councilman Hewitt seconded motion, Motion passed.
