RESOLUTION 80

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, REQUIRING A PORTION OF BUILDING PERMIT FEES TO BE DEPOSITED WITH THE CLERK UPON SUBMITTING A BUILDING PERMIT APPLICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR SAID DEPOSIT TO BE NON-REFUNDABLE AND APPLIED TO APPLICATION PROCESSING COSTS AND THE TOTAL BUILDING PERMIT FEE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is necessary for the City to collect in advance a portion of building permit fees to be used to offset building permit application processing costs incurred by the city prior to the ability to calculate and prior to receipt of the total permit fee amount; and

WHEREAS, the City has established building permit fees by separate ordinance and resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho, that:

Effective February 13, 2012, A non-refundable monetary deposit shall be submitted together with a building permit application. Said deposit shall be applied to the direct costs incurred by the City with any remaining amount being applied to the total building permit fee. Monetary deposits are hereby set at:


\$600 for Building Permits for Residential and Commercial Uses
\$300 for Building Permits for Accessory Structures and Snow Roofs

Upon a motion and second to approve the foregoing Resolution, the following vote was recorded:


