

2014 RESOLUTION 104

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, ESTABLISHING FOR FUTURE WATER CONNECTION FEES TO THE WATER TREATMENT FACILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the best interest of the City to set water connection fees capable of supporting infrastructure, facilities and debt repayment necessary for the City's water service; and

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 131 establishes provisions for calculating and assessing various water connection fees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has completed a review of the water connection fee study by contracted T-O Engineers, analyzing water connection fees for future water connections to the Dover Water Facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho, that:

EFFECTIVE December 15th, 2014, each Water Connection (ERU) is hereby set at Five Thousand Three Hundred and Ninety Two Dollars per Equivalent Residential Unit (\$5,392 per ERU)
