

2014 RESOLUTION 105

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, ESTABLISHING FOR FUTURE WASTEWATER CONNECTION FEES TO THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the best interest of the City to set wastewater connection fees capable of supporting infrastructure, facilities and debt repayment necessary for the City's wastewater service; and

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 104 establishes provisions for calculating and assessing various wastewater connection fees by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, has completed a review of the connection fee study by contracted T-O Engineers, analyzing connection fees for future wastewater connections to the Dover Wastewater Treatment facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho, that:

EFFECTIVE upon publication of Ordinance 136 each Waste Water Connection (ERU) is hereby set at Four Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty Six Dollars per Equivalent Residential Unit (\$4,726 per ERU).

The following roll call vote was recorded by the City Council of the City of Dover, Idaho on December 11, 2014.


