

RESOLUTION NO. 117

CITY OF DOVER

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, CALCULATING EQUIVALENT RESIDENTIAL UNITS FOR SEWER USERS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 144 allows for the city to establish the calculation of Equivalent Residence Units (ERU) for sewer users by resolution;

**WHEREAS**, certain terms used in this resolution are defined in Ordinance No. 144, such as ERU, single-family residence, and multi-family residence.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the mayor and Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho, that:

**SECTION 1: DETERMINATION OF EQUIVALENT RESIDENTIAL UNITS**

- 1.1 Single family residences shall be assessed one (1) ERU.
- 1.2 Multi-family residences shall be assessed the number of ERUs equal to 0.75 times the total number of living units.
- 1.3 Commercial properties shall be assessed the number of ERUs equal to the number of water ERUs for the user.
- 1.4 Residential developments that have shared sewer service connections shall be assessed the number of ERUs equal to 1.00 times the total number of living units in the development.
- 1.5 Where the user receives its water from a source other than the city, the user will have its wastewater ERUs determined by the city on an individual basis, in such a manner as to approximate potential wastewater service requirements. However, under no circumstances will the determination be less than 1 ERU.

**SECTION 2: EFFECTIVE DATE**

This resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval.
