

ORDINANCE NO. 20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DOVER, BONNER, COUNTY, IDAHO AMENDING THE DATE OF, AND LOCATION FOR, THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER TO PROVIDE THAT THE MEETINGS WILL BE HELD ON THE FIRST THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH AT 7:30 P.M. AT THE WEST SIDE FIRE STATION HALL OR THE COMMUNITY HALL WITHIN THE CITY OF DOVER.

WHEREAS, the City of Dover enacted an ordinance to establish the regular monthly meeting of the council of the City of Dover on August 9, 1988, and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provided that regular meetings of the city council were to be held on the second Tuesday of each month at the Dover Community Hall, commencing at the hour of 7:30 p.m., and

WHEREAS, the city council has determined that the regular monthly meetings should be changed to the first Thursday of each month and to be held either at the Dover Community Hall or the West Side Fire Station Hall,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER, BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: CHANGE OF DATE AND PLACE OF MONTHLY MEETING. The regular monthly meeting of the City Council shall be held on the first Thursday of each month either at the West Side Fire Station Hall or the Dover Community Hall, commencing at the hour of 7:30 p.m..

SECTION 2: The first meeting subject to this amendment shall be the regular monthly meeting for December, 1992, and shall be held at 7:30 p.m. on December 3, 1992.


SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication, as provided by law, in the Sandpoint Daily Bee.

THIS ORDINANCE PASSED under suspension of the rules and duly enacted as an Ordinance of the City of Dover, Idaho, at its regular meeting of the Council on the 10th day of November, 1992.
