

ORDINANCE NO. 179

CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DOVER, BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO, ENTITLED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$5,150,129 TO DEFRAY THE PROPER EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO, FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION §50-1003, IDAHO CODE, AUTHORIZING SUFFICIENT TAXABLE PROPERTY AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho:

SECTION 1: The sum of \$5,150,129 be, and the same appropriated, to defray the necessary and proper expenses and liabilities of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho for the fiscal year beginning the 1st of October, 2022.

SECTION 2: The objects and purposes for which such appropriations are made, as follows:

SECTION 3: The City Clerk of the City of Dover is hereby directed to file a copy of this Ordinance with the County Commissioners of Bonner County, Idaho pursuant to Idaho Code §63-804.

SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY

The sections of this ordinance are severable. Should any sections of this ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections.
