

**CITY OF DOVER
ORDINANCE NUMBER 79**

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2005, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$1,032,197.00 TO DEFRAY THE EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO FOR THE SAID FISCAL YEAR AUTHORIZING A LEVY OF SUFFICIENT TAXABLE PROPERTY AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho.

Section 1: That the sum of \$1,032,197.00 be, and the same appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2005.

Section 2: The objects and purposes for which appropriation is made, and the amount of each object is as follows:


Section 3: That a general tax levy on all taxable property within the City of Dover be levied in an amount allowed by law for the general purposes for said City, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2005.


Section 4: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its passage, approval and publication in one issue of the Bonner County Daily Bee, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Dover, and the official newspaper of such said City.
