

ORDINANCE NO. 145

CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF DOVER, BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO, ENTITLED THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2016, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$1,348,050 TO DEFRAY THE PROPER EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO, FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-1003, IDAHO CODE, AUTHORIZING SUFFICIENT TAXABLE PROPERTY AND SPECIFYING THE OBJECTS AND PURPOSES FOR WHICH SAID APPROPRIATION IS MADE; PROVIDING FOR A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE TO BE FILED WITH THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho:

**SECTION 1:** The sum of \$1,348,050 be, and the same appropriated to defray the necessary and proper expenses and liabilities of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho for the fiscal year beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2016.

**SECTION 2:** The objects and purposes for which such appropriations are made, as follows:

**SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY**

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in one (1) issue of the Bonner County Daily Bee newspaper, as provided by law.

**PASSED** by roll call vote of the City Council at a convened meeting of the Dover City Council held on the 22nd day of September 2016.


