

ORDINANCE NO. 152

CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DOVER, BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 145, THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER, 1, 2016; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONIES FOR GENERAL AND STREET FUNDS DUE TO UNFORESEEN EXPENSES; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO FILE A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH THE IDAHO SECRETARY OF STATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in March, 2017, the Ontario Street culvert failed resulting in unanticipated repair expenses to the Street Fund.

WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 2016/2017, the building permit activity in the City of Dover is unexpectedly more than double what was budgeted in the General Fund.

WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 2016/2017 the City of Dover had it's first Community Assisted Visit from FEMA for flood plain compliance resulting in unexpected Planning and Zoning expenses.

WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 2016/2017 City Council approved the painting of City Hall, that had been budgeted and approved in the previous fiscal year General Fund budget, but was not completed

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 145, the appropriation ordinance for the City of Dover, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2016, be, and the same is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2: The City Clerk of the City of Dover is hereby directed to file a copy of this Ordinance with the Idaho Secretary of State, pursuant to Idaho Code 50-1003.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY

The sections of this ordinance are severable. Should any sections of this ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in one (1) issue of the Bonner County Daily Bee newspaper, as provided by law.
