

ORDINANCE NO. 162

CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DOVER, BONNER COUNTY, IDAHO, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 156, THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2018; APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL REVENUE FOR STREET FUNDS DUE TO UNFORESEEN REVENUE REIMBURSEMENT; DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO FILE A COPY OF THIS ORDINANCE WITH THE IDAHO SECRETARY OF STATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in March, 2017, the Ontario Street culvert failed.

WHEREAS, in December of 2018, the City of Dover received reimbursement by the state for the Ontario Street culvert emergency repair work.

WHEREAS, the City of Dover recognizes this unforeseen revenue reimbursement into the FY2019 Street Fund budget.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance No. 156, the appropriation ordinance for the City of Dover, Idaho, for the fiscal year commencing October 1, 2018, be, and the same is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2: The City Clerk of the City of Dover is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Idaho Secretary of State, in Accordance with Idaho Code 50-1003.

**SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY**

The sections of this ordinance are severable. Should any sections of this ordinance be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections.

**SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE**


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in one (1) issue of the Bonner County Daily Bee newspaper, as provided by law.
