RESOLUTION NO. 62

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, ADOPTING BONNER COUNTY ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in October of 2000 the President of the United States signed into law the "Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000" (PL 106-390) to amend the "Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Act of 1988" which among other provisions requires local governments to adopt an All-Hazard Mitigation Plan in order to be eligible for hazard mitigation funding;

WHEREAS, the City of Dover has worked closely with the Bonner County Department of Emergency Management to develop a County-wide All-Hazard Mitigation Plan that will serve the needs of Dover; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dover supports the Bonner County All-Hazard Mitigation Plan as a logical means toward protecting people and property from the potential devastating effects of natural and man-made hazards;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Dover, County of Bonner, State of Idaho that:



Upon a motion and second to approve the foregoing resolution the following vote was recorded:


