

RESOLUTION NO. 135

CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, ADOPTING BONNER COUNTY ALL-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in October of 2000 the President of the United States signed into law the “Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000” (PL 106-390) to amend the “Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Act of 1988” which, among other provisions, requires local governments to adopt an All-Hazard Mitigation Plan in order to be eligible for hazard mitigation funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dover has worked closely with Bonner county Department of Emergency Management to develop a County-wide All-Hazard Mitigation Plan that will serve the needs of Dover; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dover supports the Bonner County All-Hazard Mitigation Plan as a logical means toward protecting people and property from the potential devastating effects of natural and man-made hazards.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO:
