

RESOLUTION NO. 16

A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING A GENERAL CITY
ELECTION TO BE HELD ON November 7, 1995
DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES, DESIGNATING
THE REGISTRAR AND DEPUTY REGISTRARS, AND
ORDERING THE CITY CLERK TO GIVE NOTICE OF
SUCH ELECTION.

BEITRESSOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The general city election
will be held in and for the city of Dover,
on the 7th day of November, 1995, at which
time there will be elected a mayor and 1
(one) council member for a term of four
and 2 (two) council members to serve a term
two years, or until the election and
and qualification of their successors.

SECTION 2. The following are
designated as the polling place for
such election:

FOR THE FIRST PRECINCT:

DOVER COMMUNITY HALL

SECTION 3. The Clerk, for and on

behalf of the Mayor and Council, shall give public notice of the time and place of holding such general city election by posting such notice in three public places or publishing such notice in at least two issues of the Bonner County Daily Bee, a newspaper printed and published in the city of Dover, Idaho, and first publication of such notice to be made not less than 45 days previous to the date of such city election and the last publication not less than 15 days prior to the election; the notice so published shall state the polling place in each precinct and the hours during which the polls shall be open for the purpose of voting; said notice contain such information in accordance with the requirements of Section 50-436 of the Idaho Code.
