**RESOLUTION NO. 47**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, SETTING NEW USER FACILITY FEES FOR CITY WATER USERS; ESTABLISHING NEW USER FACILITY FEES FOR COMMERCIAL CONNECTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the best interests of the City to set new user facility fees (NUFF) capable of supporting operations, maintenance and debt repayment; and

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 105 establishes provisions for calculating and assessing various water facility charges by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, at a duly noticed regular meeting on April 15, 2008 considered calculations dated February 19, 2008 from the City Engineer regarding establishing a new user facility fee (NUFF) for future water connections to the Water Treatment facility; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed Public Hearing on May 13, 2008, for citizen comment regarding the New User Facility Fee (NUFF) for future water connections.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho, that:


Effective June 1, 2008 the New User Facility Fee for each water connection is hereby set at Eight Thousand Twenty-Two and 75/100 Dollars (\$8,022.75).

Upon suspension of the rules and a motion and a second to approve the foregoing Resolution, the following vote was recorded:
