RESOLUTION NO. 58

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, SETTING FEES FOR DELINQUENT UTILITY BILLS; SETTING DISCONNECT AND RECONNECT FEES FOR UTILITIES; SETTING A UTILITY DEPOSIT AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have determined that it is in the best interests of the City to set new fees regarding utilities, utility billing and the administration thereof, including but not limited to a joint agreement with Syringa Water District; and

WHEREAS, City Ordinances Nos. 47 and 62 establish provisions for setting all fees, service charges and fines by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed Public Hearing on June 11, 2009, for citizen comment regarding new fees, fines and deposits related to utility billing and the administration thereof.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Dover, Bonner County, Idaho, that:

Effective June 11, 2009 the following fees are hereby set:


Utility Deposit	Two (2) months billing
Utility Billing Late Fee	\$25.00
Door-Hanger Service Charge	\$15.00 each
Missed Payment on Payment Plan	<u>Shut-Off</u> if not current within 30 days
Shut-Off for Water	\$100.00
Reconnect for Water	\$100.00
Restoration for Sewer	\$250.00
