

RESOLUTION NO. 35

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, ACCEPTING AND CONFIRMING THE DEDICATION OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY.

WHEREAS, Ella Mae Chronic has offered to dedicate to the City of Dover a ten foot wide strip of land adjoining the existing northern line of Washington Street as contained within Lots 1 and 2, Block 10 of the Welty Addition as recorded at Book 1 Page 112 Bonner County Book of Plats; and

WHEREAS, on December 1, 1948 Bonner County vacated the southern thirty feet of Washington Street within Block 10 of said Welty Addition resulting in a fifty foot wide right of way; and

WHEREAS, the resulting fifty foot wide right of way of Washington Street does not compare to other platted Welty Additions right of ways and does not comply with current city ordinance road development standards; and

WHEREAS, in the City Council's judgement, the acceptance of the additional right of way is in the public interest and affects the safe and efficient use of said roads; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to accept the additional right of way;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Dover, County of Bonner, State of Idaho, that:

The attached Deed of Dedication for the southern ten (10) feet of Lots 1 and 2 Block 10 of the Welty Addition plat recorded in Book 1 of Plats, Page 112, records of Bonner County, Idaho is hereby accepted and declared not to be open for public travel according to § 50-1313, Idaho Code.
