

## 2014 RESOLUTION 96

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, GRANTING EXCEPTIONS FOR WATER ERU ASSESSMENTS FOR 504 GUTHRIE PLACE, 507 GUTHRIE PLACE AND 509 GUTHRIE PLACE; PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL ACCORDING TO LAW.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 131 sets the water ERU assessment for 2" meters to five (5) ERUs and the water ERU assessment for 1 ½" meters is three (3) ERUs; and

**WHEREAS**, Condominiums with four (4) living units at 500 Guthrie Place, 502 Guthrie Place, 503 Guthrie Place, and 505 Guthrie Place are being serviced by 1 ½" meters and service lines; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2" water meters and service lines for 504 Guthrie Place, 507 Guthrie Place, and 509 Guthrie Place are oversized for servicing condominiums with four (4) living units; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dover approved the installation of the 2" water meters and service lines and wishes to avoid the cost of downsizing the 2" water meters and service lines of 504 Guthrie Place, 507 Guthrie Place, and 509 Guthrie Place; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 26 of Ordinance No. 131, the City Council may suspend the rules for assessments of certain water users if it deems it in the best interests of the City.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER AS FOLLOWS:**

The condominiums at 504 Guthrie Place, 507 Guthrie Place, and 509 Guthrie Place shall each be assessed three (3) ERUs for water service. These assessments shall not include any additional assessment(s) for standby fire protection. These assessments may be changed or revoked at any time by subsequent resolution.
