

RESOLUTION NO. 149  
CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, REGARDING THE CITY COMMITMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN A MULTI-AGENCY URBAN AREA TRANSPORTATION PLAN (UATP) AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dover will be one of 5 participating agencies including the Independent Highway District (IHD), The City of Sandpoint, The City of Ponderay, the City of Kootenai and the City of Dover, ID.

**WHEREAS** the City of Dover has provided background information so Sandpoint can prepare and submit a single UATP funding application to the Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC) on behalf of all participating agencies.

**WHEREAS** the City of Sandpoint will be the Sponsoring agency, should the funding be successful, and the Sponsor will enter into an agreement with LHTAC to administer the UATP project.

**WHEREAS** the City of Dover will participate in a consultant selection, scope and fee development and UATP development process.

**WHEREAS** The City of Sandpoint intends to contribute in-kind services as the Sponsor and consultant administrator and the City of Ponderay, Kootenai, Dover and IHD will contribute the matching funds of 0.0734% based on a negotiated consultant fee.

**WHEREAS** the City of Dover will contribute 25% of the required funding match funds for the UATP upon a successful funding application and contract award (0.01835% of the negotiated consultant fee).

**WHEREAS** The available funding and project cost may range from \$150,000 to \$250,000 resulting in a City of Dover matching rate range between \$2,752.50 to \$4,587.50. These funds would be utilized for the selected UATP consultant fees.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO THAT:**

the City of Dover is committing to the UATP funding match not to exceed \$4,587.50 and city staff participation during the development of the UATP as needed by Resolution No. 149.
