**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, SUPPORTING THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM APPLICATION SUBMITTAL**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council supports the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) application submittal for the design and construction of the Dover Pathway/National Bike Route 10 Connection project to the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD). Total project cost estimate is \$508,070.07, which will require no more than \$37,292.34 of matching funds available from the City of Dover, Idaho.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE MAYOR IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED AND DIRECTED TO SIGN THE PROJECT APPLICATION PACKET AND SUBMIT TO ITD FOR PRIORITIZATION.**


**SECTION 1: EFFECTIVE DATE** this resolution shall be in full force and effect January 9th, 2020 after its passage and approval.
