

RESOLUTION NO. 152

CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DOVER, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, APPOINTING JOHN THORPE TO A SEAT ON THE DOVER PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §67-6504(a) and Dover City Code 12-2-6(A) provide the authority for the appointment and reappointment of members to the Dover Planning and Zoning Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the Dover Mayor has the authority under Idaho Code and Dover City Code to appoint members to the Planning and Zoning Commission, subject to the confirmation by majority vote of the Dover City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has submitted the name of John Thorpe for appointment to the vacancy left by the resignation of Mark Baillie from the Dover Planning and Zoning Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, Commission Member Mark Baillie was appointed to Seat 3 on December 12, 2019 for a term expiring on July 1, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §67-6504(a)(3) establishes that vacancies are to be filled in the same manner as original appointments, and Dover City Code 12-2-6(A)(2) provides that all appointments to fill vacancies shall be for the unexpired terms of the individual being replaced; and

**WHEREAS**, John Thorpe meets the eligibility requirements of Idaho Code and Dover City Code to serve on the Commission and the appointment meets the schedule set forth by City Council at Resolution #116.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DOVER, IDAHO:** That Resolution No. 152 is hereby adopted appointing John Thorpe to fill the unexpired term to Seat 3 on the Dover Planning and Zoning Commission, beginning immediately and ending July 1, 2021.

**ENACTED** as a resolution of the City of Dover, Idaho upon a roll call vote on February 27th, 2020.


