



### *Harvest Festival Vendor Rules*

These rules apply to all vendors participating in the Harvest Festival.

1. Booths will be assigned by City Hall.
2. All material for your booth (tents, tables, signs, etc) are to be provided by the vendor.
3. Vendors may independently advertise their products for the Harvest Festival.
4. It is the responsibility of each vendor to clean his or her area prior to leaving the festival.
5. Vendors must comply with all federal, state and local laws.
6. Vendors may not discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed, sex, religion, physical ability, sexual orientation, age or nationality.
7. There will be no profanity, yelling or aggressive behavior while conducting business at the festival.
8. Vendors may set up the Friday before the festival and must be cleaned up two hours after the close of the festival.
9. Any food vendors selling food that is not considered cottage food operations by the Panhandle Health District will be required to provide a certificate of insurance naming the City of Dover as additional insured.
