



## **Harvest Festival Vendor Rules 2023**

These rules apply to all vendors participating in the Harvest Festival.

1. Booths will be assigned by City Hall.
2. All material for your booth (tents, tables, signs, etc.) are to be provided by the vendor.
3. Vendors may independently advertise their products for the Harvest Festival.
4. It is the responsibility of each vendor to clean his or her area prior to leaving the festival.
5. Vendors must comply with all federal, state, and local laws.
6. Vendors may not discriminate based on race, color, creed, sex, religion, physical ability, sexual orientation, age, or nationality.
7. There will be no profanity, yelling or aggressive behavior while conducting business at the festival.
8. Vendors may set up the Friday before the festival and must be cleaned up two hours after the close of the festival.
9. Any food vendors selling food that is not considered cottage food operations by the Panhandle Health District will be required to provide a certificate of insurance naming the City of Dover as additional insured.
10. All alcohol sales will have a permit from the City of Dover prior to the festival (cost is \$20 and application must be submitted by September 7<sup>th</sup>).
